FRP stair nosing Profile 70 is an industrial stair nosing suitable for areas which require high non slip stair safety solutions.

FRP stair nosing such as he Profile 70 is used in commercial, industrial, mining, and the oil and gas industries.

The FRP stair tread comes in two sizes, one with a 25 mm drop/riser and one with a 10 mm drop/riser.

This means that the **10mm FRP stair Nosing** is fully compliant

with AS1428 .8 2021 Australian Standards

It is a versatile stair tread and we have installed it in residential buildings, high rise apartment stairwells, fire escapes, universities and schools.




**Application**

Profile 70 stair nosing are suitable for installation on hard surface stairs such as concrete, steel, checker plate, timber etc. they can also be installed on grated stairs.

It is important to understand that the 70 mm x 25 mm FRP stair nosing is **not compliant** with AS428 2021 standards.

The contrast colour on the tread of the step against adjacent floor finishes; whether it be black or yellow **does** extend down the riser by more than 10mm.





A person may not be able to discern where the leading edge of the step is, and not lift their foot high enough to place it on the tread.

Should you need a nosing that is hazard yellow then you should look at the 10 series, this has a face of 35 mm which will protect and cover any step edge.
